Program Description:

This presentation will look at the relevance of continued service of Veterans through EMT, social work, police, fire, nursing, peer support, and other helping professions. We will discuss self disclosure among peers, benefits of peer connections especially in front line atmospheres, and best way to honor/foster continued service efforts.
